

The City of Birmingham must continue to provide City services to its citizens while responsibly responding to the COVID-19 situation within its workforce and facilities.

Effective immediately, face coverings will be required for all visitors inside City of Birmingham indoor facilities. This also applies to those who've been vaccinated against COVID-19. Facial coverings, while inside city facilities, can only be removed when eating or drinking. Facial coverings are also not required at outdoor City venues. .

Please note this applies to but is not limited to City Hall, police precincts, fire stations, community centers, museums, and all other City venues. This Executive Order will be effective on **July 30, 2021**, and will remain in effect until **September 30, 2021**, unless otherwise revoked or extended. This Executive Order is also subject to federal and state guidelines.
