A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute an Agreement with DataWorks Plus, LLC, located at 728 North Pleasantburg Drive, Greenville, SC, under which DataWorks Plus shall provide updated hardware, software, maintenance, and support services for the MUGSHOT and fingerprinting systems used by the Birmingham Police Department, for a term of three years, and the City shall pay DataWorks Plus an amount not to exceed \$40,950.00 annually, subject to an appropriation by the City in the corresponding fiscal year budget.
