Rick Jackson presented an updated on the Birmingham Water Works to the Committee.

The BWW has encountered challenges with billing, particularly meter reading, and is diligently working to rectify those issues.

The number of customers who had not been billed or had started to receive multiple bills has decreased from 13,000 down to approximately 2,100 (1% of customer base).

The BWW has finalized a new bill design. With the new bill design, it will eliminate the possibility of customers ever receiving multiple bills. The new bill is easier to understand. The release date is September 1, 2022.

The BWW is entering budget season; preparing for the 2023 budget.

The BWW is trying to complete as many construction projects as possible before the current budget is over

The Board invested \$30 million into water main replacements.
