Memorandum of a Right-of-Way Use Agreement -----Johnny Mickles

Item 1: Right of Way Encroachment License Agreement between the City of Birmingham and Birmingham Landmarks, Inc., regarding the proposed installation of one (1) sidewalk extension with a covered drainage trench and nine (9) bollards, for the purpose to protect the existing Marquee from damage. The structures will be installed along the front of the building located at 1817 – 3rd Avenue, North, as shown on Exhibit A.

Item 2: Memorandum of Understanding between the City of Birmingham and Flock Group, Inc. dba Flock Safety on behalf of Jefferson County Sheriff’s Office, regarding the proposed installation of (2) 12’ Flock poles with license plate reading cameras and solar panels, for the purpose of public safety. The structures will be installed along the westbound and eastbound of East Lake Blvd, as shown on Exhibit A.

Item 3: Right of Way Encroachment License Agreement between the City of Birmingham and HUB Community Development Corporation, Inc., regarding the proposed installation of six (6) outward swinging doors and one (1) blade sign, for the purpose of offering worthwhile opportunities for advancement, achievement, and success for people of all ages, ethnicities, and nationalities. The structures will be installed along the exterior of the building located at 1709 – 1st Avenue, North, as shown on Exhibit A.

Item 4: A request for approval of a final plat resurveying acreage into 25 lots and the dedication of Sydney Drive, Sydney Pass, and Sydney Park called THE GRAND OF OXMOOR PHASE 2.
