Memorandum of a Right-of-Way Use Agreement, Johnny Mickles

Item 1: Right of Way Encroachment License Agreement between the City of Birmingham and Birmingham Landmarks, Inc., regarding the proposed installation of one (1) sidewalk extension with a covered drainage trench and nine (9) bollards, for the purpose to protect the existing Marquee from damage. The structures will be installed along the front of the building located at $1817 - 3^{RD}$ Avenue, North, as shown on Exhibit A. **Action Taken:**

The structures will be installed along the westbound and eastbound of East Lake Blvd, as shown on Exhibit A.
