A Resolution authorizing the Mayor to execute a Service Agreement between The City of Birmingham and ADT Security for Security Cameras at the Crossplex and Bill Harris Arena for a total not to exceed One Hundred Forty Four Thousand Three Hundred Sixty Five Dollars and 25/100 Dollars (\$144,365.25). A Resolution pursuant to \$11-40-1, \$11-47-19, \$11-47-11 and \$11-43-55 of the Code of Alabama, 1975, to authorize the Mayor to expend funds and execute agreements for the Birmingham Police Department ("BPD") to host a ten-week Community Police Academy program at the Birmingham Police Academy, beginning April 4, 2023 and ending June 6, 2023. There will be no cost to attend the program, which is designed to give participants a clear insight of BPD through first-hand training in a classroom setting. Program presentations will include drinks and snacks to be provided to the attendees, and the program will be designed to increase communication, reduce crime and improve the quality of life throughout the City. The Mayor shall be authorized to execute such contracts as may be necessary for the program in accordance with Birmingham General City Code \$3-1-7 and shall be authorized to accept and make generic solicitations of donations to cover the City's costs for the public event. The total amount to be expended for the program shall not exceed a total of Ten-Thousand and OO/100 Dollars (\$10,000.00). Said funds to come from G/L O31_202_39000_39004.527-050 (Event Center & Catering) and G/L O31_202_39000_39001.523-006 (Food / Catering only). An Ordinance in accordance with Act 1969-916 of the Acts of Alabama, authorizing the Chief of Police to execute a 2023 Cooperative Agreement and Cost Reimbursement Agreement for a period not to exceed Three (3) years, between the Federal Bureau of Investigation ("FBI") and the City of Birmingham, for its Police Department ("BPD"), for participation of BPD Officers in the FBI's North Alabama Joint Terrorism Task Force ("NAJTTF") and for reimbursement to the City of Birmingham for overtime payments made to BPD officers assigned to work full time on NAJTTF related matters. Forfeitures attributable to NAJTTF investigations may be equitably shared with the agencies participating in the NAJTTF. The Chief of Police is further authorized to execute all documents necessary to accomplish the purpose of the Agreement.
