**An Ordinance pursuant to Alabama Act 1969-916, authorizing the Mayor and the Fire Chief to execute a Mutual Fire and EMS Aid Agreement between the City of Birmingham and the Rocky Ridge Fire/Rescue District, for the purpose of providing the most efficient life-saving services to the citizens of both Birmingham and the Rocky Ridge Fire/Rescue District, by providing reciprocal fire and rescue assistance on a first response basis utilizing the nearest units to the incident from either party and to otherwise assist when fire or accidents are too great to be dealt with unassisted. The Term of the Agreement shall not exceed three years.**

**An Ordinance, pursuant to Alabama Act 1969-916, authorizing the Chief of Police to execute an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement between the City of Birmingham and the UNITED STATES MARSHALS SERVICE, (the "USMS") for the purpose of authorizing the Birmingham Police Department (the "BPD") to assign BPD Officers to assist the USMS Task Force in apprehending fugitives, and the USMS will provide for the reimbursement of certain overtime costs and other expenses for work performed by the BPD Officers. The Term of the Agreement shall not exceed a period of three (3) years from its effective date. **A Resolution pursuant to §11-40-1, §38-2-9, 11-47-19, §11-47-11 and §11-43-55 of the Code of Alabama, 1975, to authorize the Mayor to expend funds and execute agreements for a Birmingham Police Department ("BPD") to host a Back-to-School Bookbag Giveaway and Resource Fair for the inhabitants of the City at the Birmingham Police Headquarters building on Saturday August 5, 2023. The Mayor and the Chief of Police are authorized to solicit generically, through such means as billboards, radio ads or other indirect means, participation of local vendors in the event and donations of items to provide for the care and emotional support of poor and needy children attending schools within the City. The event will promote the resources of the City, allow participating vendors to assist those children in need of care by providing access to free school supplies and bookbags for use in school activities. The Mayor shall be authorized to execute such contracts as may be necessary for the hosting of the BPD event, promotion of the associated resources of the City and providing for the care and emotional support of poor and needy school children through vendor/sponsor participation in the event, in accordance with Birmingham General City Code §3-1-7.**
