 - Vacation of Right of Way-----Roderick Lowe
 - **Item 1:** A request for favorable recommendation regarding the vacation of 100,670 square feet of right of way, and a request for approval of a final plat combining the vacated right of way and 49 lots into 1 lot called BIRMINGHAM AMPHITHEATER RESURVEY.
 - Item 2: A request for favorable recommendation regarding the vacation 2,833 square feet of alleyway and request for approval of a final plat combining a portion of the vacated right of way and 4 lots into 1 lot called A RESURVEY OF LOTS 4 AND 5, BLOCK 746 CITY OF BIRMINGHAM SURVEY AND ALLEY VACATION.

 - Item 4: A request for the Community Development Committee to review property that has 0 voided repair permits. 5836 Court O. On October 19, 2023, Jefferey Williams c/o Evelyn Conner, 1733 McMillon Avenue SW Birmingham, AL 35211 submitted an application for a Special Repair Permit. This property was condemned by City Council on December 6, 2022.

- Right of Way Encroachment License Agreement------Albert Jackson
 - Item 5: A request from Powell Steam Plant, LLC and Alabama Power Company to perform improvements on the Powell Steam Plant Building, by constructing and installing concrete curbs and gutters, concrete paving, storm water pipe, grease traps, lift stations, shoring trench boxes, sample wells, pump stations, overhead louvered doors, a landing ramp with handrail, light poles, brick pavers, and utility water lines, all of the improvements are part of the overall development of the property located at 1830 Powell Avenue South.
 - Item 6: A request from Jem-Realty, LLC regarding the proposed installation of fire and domestic water lines, a concrete vault, a back flow preventer, ductile iron pipe, pvc pipe, fire and domestic mag meters. All of the facilities will be installed to provide water service to a new Warehouse for the Blue Linx Project, located at 1021 2nd Court West.

 - Item 7: A request from Kettle Brothers, LLC regarding the proposed installation of one (1) vent duct, for the purpose of exhausting fumes. The sign will project from exterior of building located at 313 20th Street, North.
 - Item 8: A request from FF/RMI 20 Midtown, LLC, regarding the proposed installation of twenty (20) blade signs, for the purpose of tenant location in the 20 Midtown Apartments Development Complex. The signs will project from exterior of building located at 200 – 20th Street, South.
