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#### Right of Way Encroachment License Agreement, Albert Jackson

**Item 1:** A request from Jem-Realty, LLC regarding the proposed installation of fire and domestic water lines, a concrete vault, a back flow preventer, ductile iron pipe, PCV pipe, fire and domestic mag meters. All of the facilities will be installed to provide water service to a new Warehouse for the Blue Linx Project, located at 1021 2nd Court West.

#### Action Taken:

Councilor Moore asked if the applicant was allowed to move forward with the right of way encroachment (approved by the Committee) if language could be included to require the applicant to come back to do a vacation.

Per Mr. Jackson, that requirement is included in the agreement. A liability clause is also included in the Right of Way Encroachment Agreement. The Right of Way Encroachment Agreement includes liability clauses; it is short term, and the applicant has to apply for the vacation of the right of way. Action Taken:

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• The cameras will provide the UAB Police Department with alerts to identify desired or unpermitted vehicles, thereby helping their police department to work more efficiently in monitoring real-time events around campus.
