  - Right of Way Encroachment License Agreement------Johnny Mickles
    - Item 1: Right of Way Encroachment License Agreement between the City of Birmingham and Children's of Alabama, regarding the proposed installation of one (1) door and one (1) concrete, landing, for the purpose of parking deck security. The structures will project from exterior of building located at 430 – 17th Street, South, as shown on the attached <u>Exhibit A</u>.
    - Item 2: Right of Way Encroachment License Agreement between the City of Birmingham and Synovus Bank, regarding the proposed installation of a flag sign, for the purpose of advertisement location. The sign will project from the exterior of the building located at 205 20<sup>th</sup> Street, North, as shown on the attached Exhibit B.
    - Item 3: Right of Way Encroachment License Agreement between the City of Birmingham and Ventura Foods, LLC, regarding the proposed installation of one (1) fence for the purpose of worker and public safety. The structure will project from the property located at 430 17th Street, South, as shown on the attached Exhibit C.
    - Item 4: Right of Way Encroachment License Agreement between the City of Birmingham and 2205 3rd Avenue, LLC, regarding the proposed installation of outward swinging doors and awnings with attached signs, for the purpose of new building restorations. The awnings and doors will project from the exterior of the building located at 2205 – 3rd Avenue, North,

as shown on the attached Exhibit D.

- Right of Way Encroachment License Agreement------Albert Jackson
  - Item 5: Request for the approval of a Right of Way Encroachment Agreement between the Avondale Property Company d/b/a Avondale Brewing Company and the City of Birmingham regarding the proposed installation of a 5-feet wide concrete walkway, two (2) outward swinging doors, an existing 5-feet wide by 50-feet long metal staircase, and an existing utility gas meter. The facilities will be installed as part of a renovation project for Avondale Brewing Company, located at 201 41st Street South, and encroach into, and upon the rights of way of 2nd Avenue South, as shown on the attached Exhibit E.
